“American Folk tales”

Folk tales are made-up stories about animals or human beings.

They are created by ordinary people and passed down by word of mouth .A folk tale may come from any country. The setting for a folk tale is usually the country or area from which the folk tale arose.

Folk tales often tell about local heroes and their deeds. As a folk tale is retold from one generation to the next, characters and events may change or become more exaggerated .Some folk tales use the characters and events to show the right way to behave or to explain the ways of nature. A folk tale usually has a happy ending, with the good being rewarded and the bad being punished. The following is an example of an American folk tale.

Oklahoma was offering land to whoever claimed it first. Legal Lyle lined up with thousands of other settlers, each one of them eager to claim a portion of the open territory as their home. Alongside Lyle was Dirty Dan, known for his low-down ways. A gun signaled the start of the race for home sites. For several hours, Dirty Dan rode his horse right behind Legal Lyle. With the sun nearly setting, Lyle finally stopped his horse, slid down from the saddle, and hammered a stake into a parcel of land. This was now his property. Dirty Dan did the same with a piece of land right next to Lyle's.

That evening, Dirty Dan thought: "My land doesn't look as nice as Lyle's" So while Lyle slept peacefully, Dirty Dan switched the two stakes. In the morning, he accused Lyle of sleeping on his property and threw him off. Now, this story might have had a sad ending except for one minor detail. The next day, Lyle's dog began barking like the dickens. Something about the land was making him howl,ooooooooiiiiiiiii!" And that's just what they found oil on the property. Dirty Dan had given up when he switched the stakes. Legal Lyle became one of the richest men in the state. And Dirty Dan cried every day for the rest of his life.

**Критерии оценивания тестов для учащихся 5-11 классов
по Английскому языку**

1. Тесты для учащихся 5-11 классов – это задания в закрытой форме (*выбором одного правильного ответа*).
2. Тест содержит задания средней сложности.
3. Каждое правильно выполненное задание оценивается в 1 балл.
4. **Максимальный балл за всю работу:**
для 5-7 классов – это 10 т/з - 10 баллов.
для 8-11 классов – это 15 т/з - 15 баллов.
5. Оценивание работ проводится на основании правильных ответов и шкале перевода баллов в пятибалльную систему оценивания.
